To All Parties and to Their Attorneys of Record:

On October 6, 2006, following remand by the Court of Appeal from an order granting Defendant Fax.com's and Pacific Coast Office Products, Inc.'s demurrer to the 1<sup>st</sup> Amended Complaint, the matter came regularly for trial in Department 323 of the Superior Court, before the Honorable Carolyn Kuhl, sitting without a jury.

1 Plaintiffs David Amkraut and Joel Amkraut, appearing individually and for a class  
2 of other similarly situated, appeared by Jamie R. Schloss. There were no other  
3 appearances. The following facts and findings are noted:

4 Plaintiffs filed their complaint on November 20, 2000. Plaintiffs subsequently  
5 named and sued defendant Fax.com as Doe 1. Defendant Fax.com appeared in the action  
6 when it filed a demurrer to the 1<sup>st</sup> Amended complaint. The demurrer was granted.  
7 However, plaintiffs appealed. The appeal was successful. The Court of Appeal reversed  
8 the order sustaining demurrer and remanded for further proceedings.

9 Upon remand, Defendant Fax.com did not answer nor did it respond to discovery  
10 requests from plaintiffs. Defendant Fax.com requested the case be consolidated with  
11 other pending Class Actions.

12 Over plaintiffs' objections, this action was ordered consolidated with other  
13 pending actions into *In Re TCPA Cases*, JCCP #4350. Eventually, the matter was  
14 assigned to Judge McCoy. In 2004, based on Fax.com's non-compliance with discovery  
15 obligations and the stipulation of its counsel Mr. James Casello, the Court entered default  
16 against defendant Fax.com.

17 Meanwhile, the case continued against the other defendants. On November 10,  
18 2005, the Court certified this action as a class action, confirmed plaintiffs David and Joel  
19 Amkraut as class representatives, confirmed Jamie R. Schloss as class counsel, and  
20 defined the Class as:

21 "All persons, businesses, or entities in California who received,  
22 through telephone facsimile machines, unsolicited facsimile advertisements  
23 advertising Defendant Pacific Coast Office Products's ("PCOP") goods or  
24 services, all of which Defendant Fax.com or Defendant Cynet, Inc. sent on  
25 PCOP's behalf. The Class shall be composed of two sub-classes: 1) those  
26 who received unsolicited PCOP facsimile advertisements sent by Fax.com;  
27 and 2) those who received unsolicited PCOP facsimile advertisements sent  
28 by Cynet, Inc."

26 In 2005, the Court confirmed dismissal of defendant Cynet, Inc. sued as Doe 2, as  
27 said defendant had filed for bankruptcy.

1 On September 12, 2006, plaintiffs and the Class completed an approved settlement  
2 with Defendant Pacific Coast Office Products for \$250,000.00 and a stipulated injunction.

3 On September 12, 2006, plaintiffs' counsel noted that it was unclear whether Mr.  
4 Casello had authority in fact to stipulate to default for defendant Fax.com. Counsel  
5 requested the default against Fax.com be set aside so the matter could proceed to trial  
6 against defendant Fax.com. This request was granted.

7 Defendant Fax.com was served with notice of trial on September 12, 2006 and on  
8 September 14, 2006. Defendant Fax.com did not appear for trial. Trial commenced at  
9 approximately 1:45 p.m. The court deemed Fax.com to have answered the complaint by  
10 filing a general denial, and proceeded to trial against defendant Fax.com.

11 Having considered the evidence and legal arguments of both parties and taking  
12 testimony from witnesses Pacific Coast Office Products (by Declaration), David Amkraut  
13 and Joel Amkraut, and taking judicial notice of various facts and documents, and having  
14 admitted various exhibits and other evidence, the Court rules as follows:

15 **It is hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed:**

16 Good cause having been shown, the Court grants plaintiffs Joel Amkraut, David  
17 Amkraut, and the Class judgment against Defendant Fax.com as follows:

18 **The Class (CRC Rule 1861)**

19 1. The Court finds the members of the Class to be:

20 "All persons, businesses, or entities in California who received,  
21 through telephone facsimile machines, unsolicited facsimile advertisements  
22 advertising Defendant Pacific Coast Office Products's ("PCOP") goods or  
23 services which Defendant Fax.com sent on PCOP's behalf. The Class shall  
be composed of only the sub-class which received unsolicited PCOP  
facsimile advertisements sent by Fax.com, rather than the whole class  
previously approved."

24 **Judgment against Defendant Fax.com**

25 2. The Court finds that defendant Fax.com willfully and knowingly violated the  
26 Telephone Consumers Protection Act of 1991 codified at 47 USC § 227 ("TCPA") by  
27 sending 169,215 advertisements by facsimile transmission which advertised defendant  
28 Pacific Coast Office Products's goods and services. The Court finds that, because

1 Fax.com acted willfully and knowingly, that there is good cause to treble the \$500.00  
2 statutory damages to \$1,500.00 per violation pursuant to 47 USC § 227(b)(3).

3 3. Plaintiff Joel Amkraut to have judgment against Defendant Fax.com in the  
4 amount of \$1,500.00;

5 4. Plaintiff David Amkraut to have judgment against Defendant Fax.com in the  
6 amount of \$7,500.00;

7 5. Joel Amkraut and David Amkraut, as representatives of the Class (as defined  
8 above) to have judgment against Defendant Fax.com in the amount of Two hundred fifty  
9 three million, eight hundred thirteen thousand, and five hundred dollars  
10 (\$253,813,500.00).

11 **Further Order re: Notice and Distribution of Funds**

12 6. Any monies collected on the Class or other judgments shall be deposited in  
13 class counsel's attorney client trust account. Class counsel shall notify the Court of any  
14 collection within thirty days, and the Court shall then make such further orders regarding  
15 Notice and order direct distribution of said sums and determine any attorney fee award.

16 7. Class Counsel shall publish notice of this judgment on the Class Website  
17 unless further ordered.

18 **General Orders on Judgment**


19 The foregoing judgments are to bear interest at the rate of 10% per annum from  
20 June 30, 2000 to the date of entry of judgment. Plaintiffs are additionally awarded  
21 \$ \_\_\_\_\_ in costs of suit. The Court reserves jurisdiction to order attorney fees for Class  
22 Counsel upon motion for good cause shown or if any monies are collected on the  
23 judgment as set forth above.

24 **It is so ordered.**


