I am writing on behalf of my client, DigitalSpeed Communications, Inc. ("DigitalSpeed"), regarding the inaccurate and unfair statements concerning DigitalSpeed and its business practices contained on your website located at the following URL: <http://www.junkfax.org>. By this letter, DigitalSpeed hereby demands that you immediately remove all statements concerning DigitalSpeed and its business practices set forth in that website.

DigitalSpeed recently has become aware of the above-referenced website, which contains statements about DigitalSpeed and its business practices that are actionable under Pennsylvania's Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law, 73 PA. CONS. STAT. § 201-1 *et seq.* Specifically, your website has alleged that DigitalSpeed is a fax broadcaster. DigitalSpeed is a common carrier providing various telecommunications services to businesses in the Northeast. DigitalSpeed does not transmit, or cause to be transmitted, unsolicited facsimile advertisements to facsimile machines. Nor does DigitalSpeed offer or provide facsimile broadcasting services to any person or entity. The statements set forth in your website, therefore, are false and misleading, and serve solely to disparage DigitalSpeed's business.
